By checking the consent box in Section 8 of the paper application, you are agreeing to waive your right under the California Information Practices Act (California Civil Code section 1798 et seq.) to keep your scores confidential from anyone other than the California Veterinary Medical Board. You are consenting under California Civil Code section 1798.24 to have this information released by NBVME to the university you identified in Section 8. The California Veterinary Medical Board cannot control what your university may do with your score after it is released to them. If you consent, you may withdraw consent by contacting NBVME directly by e-mail or fax, at any time up until the opening of the testing window (November 15, 2010 or April 11, 2011). You **DO NOT** have to agree to have your score released to your university to take the NAVLE as a California candidate. By signing below, you understand and agree that if you have consented to the release of your score to anyone other than the California Veterinary Medical Board, you are waiving your rights under California law.
